ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

Regional Institute of Education (RIE), Bhubaneswar (NAAC Accredited A Grade), one of the constituent units of NCERT, New Delhi has been providing academic and technical support to the states of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Sikkim, Tripura, West Bengal and Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Union Territory) for quality improvement of school education through pre-service and in-service Teacher education programmes. However, with the establishment of North-East Regional Institute of Education (NERIE), Shillong in 2015, in-service programmes as well as pre-service B.Ed. programme for North-Eastern states have been shifted to NERIE. RIE, Bhubaneswar affiliated to Utkal University, Bhubaneswar (NAAC Accredited A⁺ Grade) runs courses approved by the National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE). The students in the 4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) are admitted through the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by NTA and the students in the 2-year B.Ed & M.Ed courses are admitted through the All-India Common Entrance Examination (CEE) conducted by NCERT. The Institute offers various Programmes / Courses as per the guidelines of the UGC, NCTE and Utkal University. The students of this institute belonging to B.A. B.Ed., B.Sc. B.Ed., B.Ed. & M.Ed. undergo internship as per the NCTE guidelines in different schools of eastern India. Multi-cultural exposure in rural, urban and tribal schools and field work with the community in rural set up are some of the important field-based activities of the programmes. The Institute has been recognized as a nodal Institute for Ph. D. Programme in Education of Utkal University. Besides Education, the faculty members of the institute are also recognized as supervisor for Ph. D. programmes in all other subjects by the Utkal University as well.

Location

This Institute is located on Sachivalaya Marg, Bhubaneswar about 5 km away from the Bhubaneswar Railway Station and 7 km away from Biju Patnaik International Airport. Bhubaneswar city is known as “Temple City of India” for its rich heritage of temples like the Lingaraj, Mukteswar, Rajarani, Kedargauri and Baital, etc.

INTEGRATED TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMME (ITEP)

National Education Policy 2020 envisions a transformative reform of teacher education in India by emphasizing quality, multidisciplinary learning, and professional standards. Recognizing teachers as the cornerstone of the education system, the policy advocates for a comprehensive restructuring of teacher preparation programmes. In alignment with this vision, the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) has been introduced as a four-year integrated undergraduate programme (B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed./B.Com. B.Ed.) that combines disciplinary knowledge with professional teacher education.

The Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) is a four-year degree programme offered at the Foundational, Preparatory, Middle and Secondary Stage. It is founded on the vision of NEP 2020, exemplifying the process of developing a multidisciplinary approach towards learning in higher education. The ITEP seeks to create a pool of competent teachers capable of designing appropriate teaching-learning practices that are responsive to the learning needs and interests of children at different stages of their development. Each student-teacher shall specialize in one of the stages of school education which will qualify him/her to become a teacher for that stage.

- i) ITEP with Foundational Stage Specialization (for teaching Pre-school to Grade 2)
- ii) ITEP with Preparatory Stage Specialization (for teaching Grades 3 to Grade 5)
- iii) ITEP with Middle Stage Specialization (for teaching Grades 6 to Grade 8)
- iv) ITEP with Secondary Stage Specialization (for teaching Grades 9 to Grade 12)

The ITEP is of four-year duration with credits distributed across eight semesters of study. It is a dual-major bachelor's degree programme, with one major in Education and the other in a disciplinary/interdisciplinary branch of knowledge. In addition, the programme seeks to develop among student-teachers a strong sense of ethical and social engagement, along with essential capacities such as problem-solving, creative and critical thinking, effective communication skills, and moral reasoning-key attributes for preparing competent and reflective teachers.

The Regional Institute of Education, NCERT, Bhubaneswar is recognised by NCTE to offer Four Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) in B.A.B.Ed. & B.Sc.B.Ed. (Middle & Secondary Stage).

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY

The minimum eligibility criteria for admission to the Integrated Teacher Education Programme(ITEP) is as under:

- Candidates with at least fifty percent marks in Senior Secondary or plus two examinations or its equivalent (under 5+3+3+4) from a recognized board are eligible for admission. The relaxation in percentage of marks in the Senior Secondary or plus two examinations or its equivalent examination (under 5+3+3+4) for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Persons with Disabilities shall be as per the rules of the Government of India.
- Candidate must have appeared in the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2026 conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA).

GENERAL INFORMATION & IMPORTANT POINTS General Information

- RIE Bhubaneswar offers the following ITEP Programmes:
 1. B.Sc.B.Ed. (Middle & Secondary Stage)
 2. B.A.B.Ed. (Middle & Secondary Stage)
- Admission to the above Programmes for the academic session 2026-27 will be carried out on the basis of the score obtained in the NCET, 2026 conducted by NTA and other conditions of eligibility requirements specified in the information brochure.
- Simply appearing in NCET-2026 will not be a sufficient condition to secure a seat in RIE Bhubaneswar. In addition to this, a candidate must apply on the official portal of RIE Bhubaneswar, to get admission to the ITEP.
- Registration schedule for the RIE Bhubaneswar portal for admission will be announced after the declaration of NCET-2026 results by NTA.
- Application submitted through any other mode or portal/website will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- Candidates are advised to keep checking the website of RIE Bhubaneswar for all schedules and updates.
- Before initiating the application process, candidates are advised to read the contents of information brochure carefully.
- Determination of eligibility and verification of documents for admission to ITEP Programmes will be the sole responsibility of RIE Bhubaneswar.
- The students who have passed class XII with any one of the following stream and subject combination are eligible to apply for admission.

Stream	Subjects
Science (B.Sc.B.Ed. Programme)	Science stream of class XII with the subjects either Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/Applied Mathematics/Statistics or Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biological Studies/Biotechnology/Biochemistry/Zoology/Botany
Arts (B.A.B.Ed. Programme)	Any stream of class XII

- Students must have appeared in the NCET-2026 conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- Institute offers ITEP (4-year integrated Dual Major programmes) with one major in Education and the other in any one of the following disciplines:
 - ❖ B.Sc.B.Ed. (Major) - Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology.
 - ❖ B.Sc.B.Ed. (Minor) - Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology.
 - ❖ B.A.B.Ed. (Major) - English & Geography
 - ❖ B.A.B.Ed. (Minor) - Bengali, Economics, English, Geography, Hindi, History, Odia, Political Science.
- The medium of instruction is English except for the language courses.
- Seat allocation to the ITEP programme will be based solely on the scores obtained in NCET-2026, subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria.
- NTA has the overall responsibility of conducting NCET 2026. In case of any claims or disputes related to NCET 2026, the NTA may be consulted.
- RIE Bhubaneswar will not be responsible for a candidate's lack of awareness of the admission guidelines, schedule, eligibility criteria, and rules of RIE Bhubaneswar for ITEP admission.
- It is the responsibility of the candidate to regularly check his/her dashboard, email, and admission website for all communications and updates related to admissions.
- Candidates have to pay a registration fee of Rs. 500/- through the automatically generated link during the online application process which is non-refundable.
- In case of non-compliance with the requirements for admission, including non-submission of relevant documents and/or non-payment of fee(s) within the stipulated date and time, the candidate will lose his/her right to admission.
- It is the responsibility of the candidate to prove his/her eligibility for claiming reservation under any of the reserved categories.
- Candidates applying under SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwD quotas will be required to upload the certificates/ documents of the respective reserved category/sub-category issued by the competent issuing authority.
- A candidate's participation in the admission process will be provisional. If, at any stage, documents submitted by the candidate relating to the admission are found to be fake, fabricated or in any other manner defective, the said candidate will not be given admission. If already admitted, admission will be cancelled without any prior notice in this regard. If the same is found after completing the programme, his/her degree will be revoked and appropriate legal action will be taken against such candidates.

- RIE Bhubaneswar will not refund the admission fee (if paid) in case a candidate is found ineligible at any stage.
- RIE Bhubaneswar reserves the right to cancel the admission of any candidate who violates the rules and regulations laid down by RIE, Bhubaneswar.
- Candidates should have passed class XII examination during last three years i.e. 2024/2025/2026.

Important Points

- For applying to the ITEP, candidates will have to pay a one-time registration Fee of Rs. 500.00 (Rupees Five Hundred Only) (non-refundable).
- The online application process will be considered completed only after the realization of the registration fee. The candidate must ensure that the registration fee is submitted only through the RIE, Bhubaneswar admission portal. Fee deposited via any other link will not be considered under any circumstances.
- If a candidate has applied for the ITEP but doesn't fulfil the eligibility criteria, his/her candidature will not be considered.
- If all the documents are found to be in order and the candidate meets the eligibility criteria, the allocated seat will be provisionally allotted. In that case, the candidate will have to take admission to the approved allocated seat by paying the admission fee within the stipulated time.
- Candidates are advised to keep the login credentials (login ID and password) strictly confidential to avoid misuse. The login credentials, once generated, cannot be changed/ edited under any circumstances.
- The candidate must adhere to the stipulated timelines of all allocation and admission rounds.
- A candidate whose documents are found to be invalid owing to wilful forgery/act of cheating will be debarred from admission.

ALLOCATION RULES

- RIE Bhubaneswar will consider the score obtained in NCET-2026 and the preference of disciplinary major subjects for the purpose of allocations.
- Preference will be given to a candidate considering the following criteria: (i) Merit (ii) Category-UR/OBC-NCL/SC/ST/EWS (iii) Availability of seats (iv) Any other allocation rules, policies, or criteria mentioned in this document or published on RIE Bhubaneswar admission website.
- The merit list for the UR category seats will comprise all candidates in order of merit.
- If candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwD category do not have a valid certificate/ document issued by the respective issuing authority at the time of admission, they will not be considered for allocation in the relevant category as claimed.

SEAT ALLOCATION AND ADMISSION

- On declaration of the seat allocation results on the website of the Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar, candidates will be invited to attend counselling at the institute.
- After counselling process provisionally admitted students will be allowed to deposit the prescribed fee for admission.
- The admission will be confirmed only after successful payment of the admission fee.

CANCELLATION OF PROVISIONALLY ALLOCATED SEAT/ADMISSION

The provisionally allocated seat will be cancelled if:

- a candidate, at any time fails to pay the admission fee within the stipulated period.
- at any time, any of the document(s)/ certificate(s) is/are found to be invalid/fraudulent.
- at any time, it is found that a candidate does not meet the minimum eligibility criteria.

TIE BREAKING

- In the event of a tie, where two or more candidates have the same NCET-2026 merit score, institute rules will be applied to break the tie.
- Tie Cases will be decided by scored of Teaching Aptitude test. Further, tie will be decided on the basis scores of Reasoning, further tie will be decided on the score of English language.

RESERVATION OF SEATS

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Seats are reserved for the candidates belonging to reserved categories as per Govt. of India and NCERT rules.
- The candidate must be in possession of a valid original Caste/Tribe certificate in his/her own name at the time of registration issued by the competent authority.
- The candidate will have to produce the valid original caste certificate issued by the competent authority at the time of admission.
- The OBC candidates who belong to the '**Non-Creamy Layer**' appears in the central list of the OBCs only, shall be eligible to be considered for admission under the OBC category as per the Govt. of India rules. Candidates belonging to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) have to produce a valid certificate issued by the competent authority.

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

Candidates shall be required to upload copies of relevant certificates/documents at the time of applying (as applicable) and produce the same certificates/documents in their original form at the time of counselling.

- NCET-2026 application form and NTA score card.
- Class X Marksheet and Certificate in the name of the candidate, indicating date of birth and Parents' names.
- Class XII Marksheet and certificate must be in the candidate's name, and the name must exactly match the application form.
- SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwD etc. Certificate (in the name of the Candidate) issued by the competent issuing authority.
- Original School/College leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate.
- Original Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied.
- Original & Valid Caste Certificate from an authority empowered to issue such a certificate i.e. Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner or any other Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar in case of SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidates. Certificate issued by any other person is not acceptable. Candidate claiming reservation under OBC category should produce certificate clearly mentioning Other Backward Caste/Class(OBC) or and not belonging to creamy layer.
- Residential/Nativity Certificate from the competent authority not below the rank of Tehsildar for the candidates claiming seat as per NCET-2026.
- Original Certificate for Persons with Disability (PwD) (not below 40%) candidates issued by the component authority not below the rank of Chief District Medical Officer.
- Valid Income Certificate of parents from the competent authority not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- Migration Certificate (if any) for Students coming from Universities other than Utkal University.
- Online Anti-ragging undertaking/ affidavit should be submitted by student & parent/guardian after confirmation of admission.
- An affidavit from a competent court or Notary Public stating that the documents, certificates, and mark sheets submitted are genuine.
- Medical Fitness Certificate from a Government Medical Practitioner not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon.
- Relieving order in case the candidate is employed.
- Photocopy of Aadhaar Card.
- Three recent passport size photographs.
- A set of self-attested photocopies of the following documents must be submitted: payment receipt, High School mark sheet and certificate, Senior Secondary (Class XII) mark sheet and certificate, category (caste/tribe) certificate (if applicable), migration certificate, fitness certificate, Aadhaar card.
- The original medical fitness certificate, leaving/transfer certificate, and conduct certificate must be submitted at the time of admission.

- Candidates must take utmost care to ensure that uploaded documents/Certificates are authentic and accurate.
- Candidates will be responsible for producing documents/ certificates as sought.
- If the original certificates are not in English/ Hindi, the English/ Hindi version/translation of such certificates, duly certified by the Principal/Director or other competent authority of the last Institute attended, will be required during the document verification.

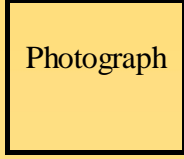
